announces a photo competition for amateur and professional photographers.

General rules

The competition is open to all amateur and professional photographers.

An author may submit up to four photos per category.

An entry can be submitted in one version and in one category only. Entrants can upload their entries after registration on the MFAE photo competition website: <http://www.mfsze.hu/palyazat> from 1 September to 12 October 2022.

In case of technical problems, please contact fotosszabadegetem@gmail.com for assistance and upload your photos.

Technical details of the images - The longest side is exactly 1920 pixels.

- Format jpg.

- Colour sRGB - Size up to 2 Mbytes.

- The applicant must have at least the minimum size of the images. The applicant must have a version of at least 3800 pixels in size.

- The name of the file to be uploaded must contain the English alphabet, numbers and the underscore character (no accented letters, spaces or graphic symbols).

- When uploading, the name of the applicant and the title of the image must be provided. You will see this and in this form wherever the image is subsequently referred to (projected exhibition, protocol, catalogue, reference).

Your name must not appear on the image.

- The image must not contain any indication (e.g. watermark) of the author.

We would ask you to name the images according to the following model:

Legislative context

The content and full legal responsibility for the submitted photos rests with the applicant. The applicant must have the permission of the persons shown in the picture.

If the image includes a minor(s), permission of a parent/guardian is required. By submitting their work, applicants declare that they have the necessary permission.

Only photographs that are the sole and exclusive property of the applicant and that do not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party may be entered.

If the photographs submitted do infringe the copyright or other proprietary rights of any other person, the applicant shall be fully liable for any claim arising therefrom and shall indemnify the MFAE against any claim.

If the author's work does not comply with the call for entries, it will not be judged and the application fee will not be refunded to the applicant by the MFSZE.

The photographs may be published free of charge in printed documents, press, books and other media (internet, television, etc...), with the name of the author, in order to promote future competitions and exhibitions organised by the MFSZE. The use of the photographs for any other purpose is authorised by the author only on the basis of a specific contract to be concluded with the applicant.

A print exhibition of the selected images in each category will be organised by the organiser.

The photos will be presented to the jury only after payment of the entry fee.

The judging will be one-round. First, second and third place will be decided by the jury on the basis of the scores (1-10 points) or, in the case of a tie, on the basis of the same score.

If the organiser of the competition is satisfied that an image has been entered which is in breach of any of the rules set out in this notice, the image concerned will be disqualified from the competition without notice to the entrant.

Categories

A. Colour - Unbound

B. Black and White - Unbound No 'nearly monochrome' images may be entered in the black and white category.

C. Nature and Landscape Correction in the processing of the image may only consist of the following digital modifications:

levels, gradation curves, whitebalance, hue/saturation and brightness/contrast, shadow/highlight, sharpening and the possibility to remove technical defects that occurred during the original image: scratches, chemical stains, dust on the light sensor. It is also possible to crop the image, remove distracting elements and change the orientation of the image. It is also allowed to convert images to black and white and to remove scanning/digitisation errors (scratches, dust) in analogue images.

Images of buildings and agricultural landscapes may be entered in the colour or black and white category.

D. Portrait

images may be entered in colour or black and white

E. Our decaying land

images may be entered in colour or black and white

F. Street

the pictures can be named in colour or black and white
